




#### CHALLENGE: REPUBLICAN SUPPORT IN HELP AND THE HOUSE

- Met with Sponsors Staff in the Senate: Ranking R's will not ok new authorizations and grant programs (Burr – NC).
- Strategy Pivot: Emphasizing The FASD Respect Act as a reauthorization bill.
- Met with Sen. Burr's staff: Confirmation of viability of strategy.
- Receptive House Republicans: Appear more receptive to the bill in meetings where the Respect Act is positioned as reauthorization.




