How do I get to Capitol Hill??


Uber and Lyft are your best bets Taxis also work



What About My Sherpa?

Where do I meet my sherpa?

Outside the visitor entrances to the Hart and Rayburn Buildings are the standard starting points *unless you* agree otherwise

How do I contact my sherpa?

We will provide you with their cell phone numbers. Please contact them in advance!

How should my sherpa help me?

Contact staffer to let them know to come get you at the visitor entrance. Escort you.

Getting Through Security

How can I get through security efficiently?

Minimize metal on you; but be prepared to remove your watches, belts. Consolidate as much as you can!

What's the travel time between the House and the Senate?


If I have another meeting, do I have to leave then come back in?


You will be provided times, with whom, and office numbers
